














Singular and Plural

Add s to most regular nouns.	a/one banana a/one flower a/one toy a/one building a/one ticket a/one car a/one balloon a/one book a/one bag a/one cookie	bananas flowers toys buildings tickets cars balloons books bags cookies


Singular and Plural

Rules	Singular	plural
If the noun ends in y; change to ies.	a (one) candy a (one) butterfly a (one) puppy	candies butterflies puppies
If the noun ends in s, ss, x, ch, or sh add es.	a (one) kiss a (one) box a (one) dish	kisses boxes dishes
If the noun ends in an o, add es.	a (one) potato a (one) tomato a (one) hero	potatoes tomatoes heroes
