





Where are you going for vacation?


Answer:

What is your favourite **method** of travel?


Answer:

Example:


Did you book a flight to **France**?


Did you book a flight to **Spain**?

# Singular and Plural

Rules	Singular	plural
If the noun ends in <b>y</b> ; change to <b>ies</b> .	a (one) candy a (one) butterfly a (one) puppy	cand <b>ies</b> butterfl <b>ies</b> pupp <b>ies</b>
If the noun ends in <b>s, ss, x, ch, or sh</b> add <b>es</b> .	a (one) kiss a (one) box a (one) dish	kiss <b>es</b> box <b>es</b> dish <b>es</b>
If the noun ends in an <b>o</b> , add <b>es</b> .	a (one) potato a (one) tomato a (one) hero	potato <b>es</b> tomato <b>es</b> hero <b>es</b>
