were not sorry for their bad ways.




They were very, very bad. God was sorry he had made

I will destroy all people and animals with a flood."




But there was one good man. His name was Noah. He worshiped God. God said to Noah, "The people of the earth are very, very bad. Because of this, I will destroy them with a flood.






But here's my plan for you to make a big boat for your family. And put some animals in the boat, too."

But Noah and his family were safe in the big boat.






