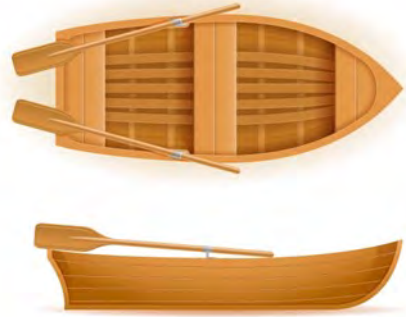

B: I'm sorry. Can you please repeat that?

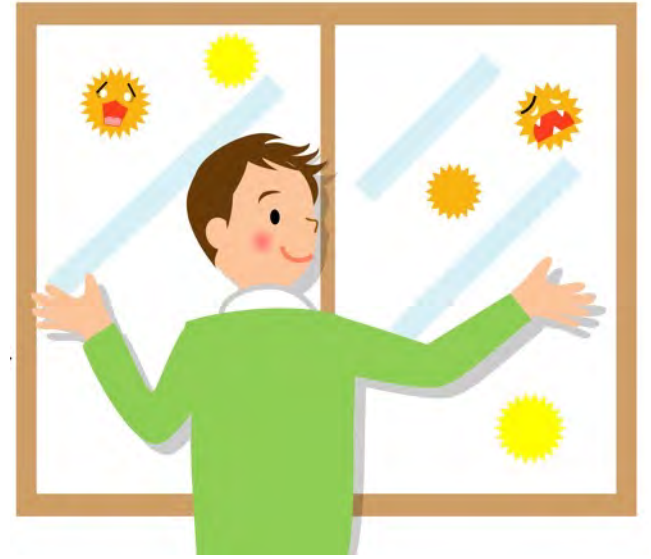

Genesis [6:9-8:22](#)

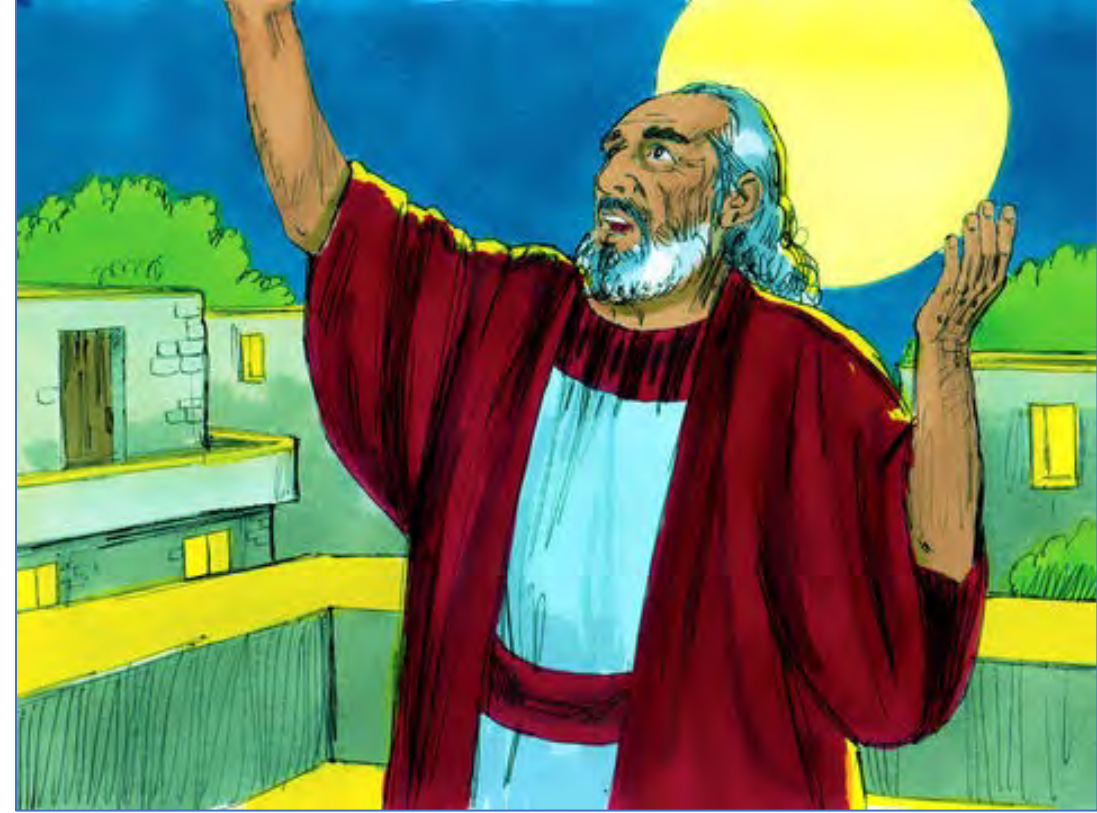
God was mad with the people on earth. He was mad because the people had many sins. People were not sorry for their bad ways..

They were very, very bad. God was sorry he had made them. God said, "Because of this I will punish the earth. I will destroy all people and animals with a flood."





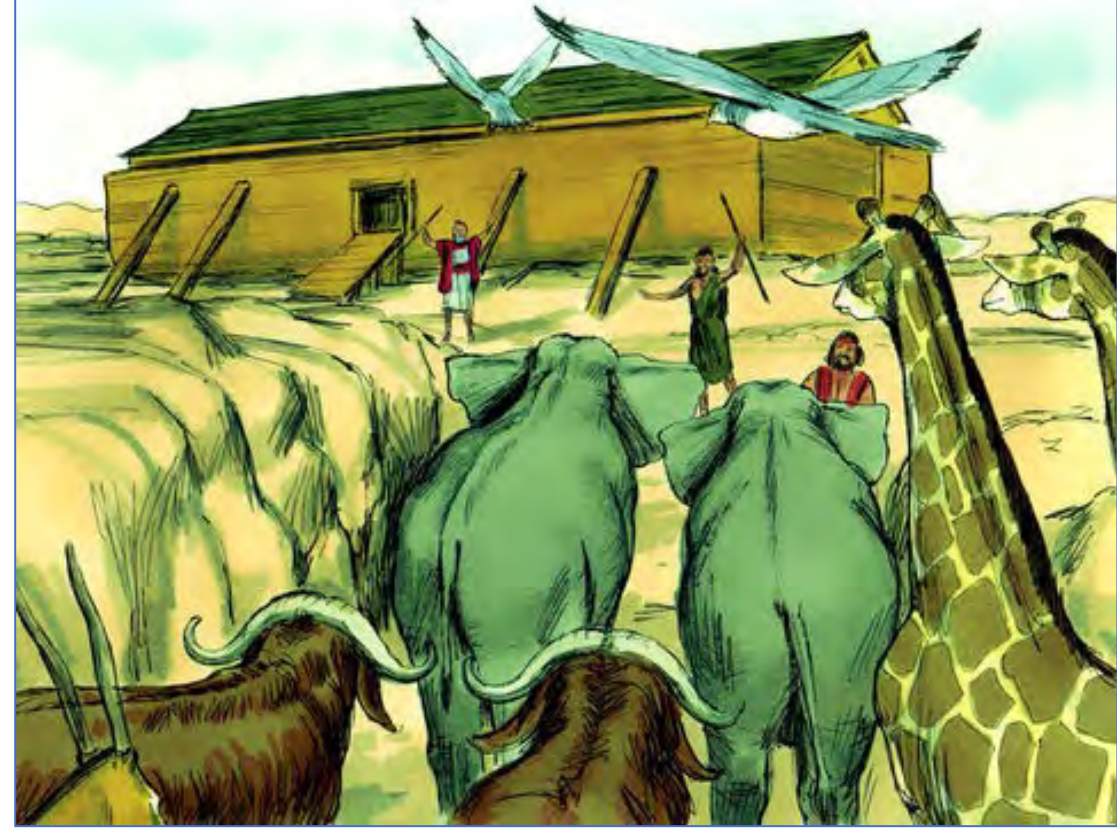
But there was one good man.

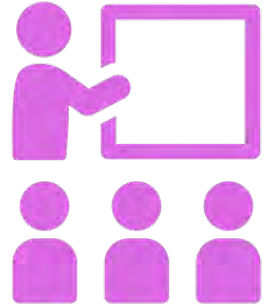

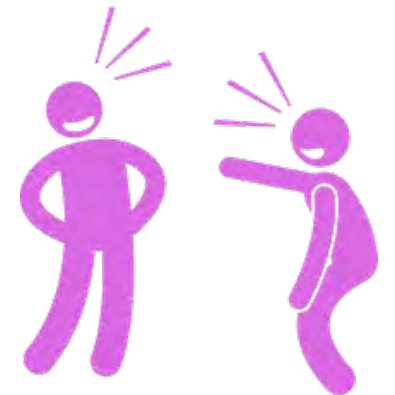
