



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

Then God said, "Is anything too hard for the Lord?"








Then Sarah gave birth to a son. Abraham and Sarah loved their son, Isaac.







After a few years, God told Abraham to go to a mountain. He told him to sacrifice his son, Isaac. Abraham obeyed.








He took his son to the mountain, and tied him. Then he took a knife to sacrifice his son, his only son.


At that moment, God called to Abraham, "Do not kill him. Now I know that you love me even more than your own son."






Then Abraham saw a sheep caught in a bush. He sacrificed the sheep to God instead.

Then God said, "I will keep my promise to you because you obeyed me. I will make you a blessing to all nations."


