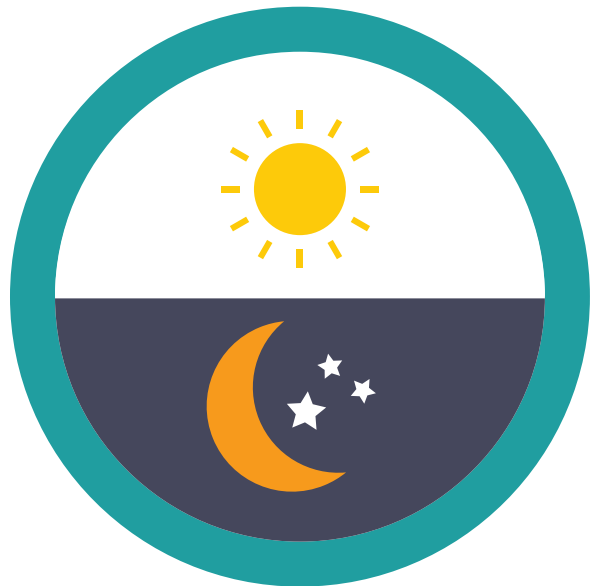
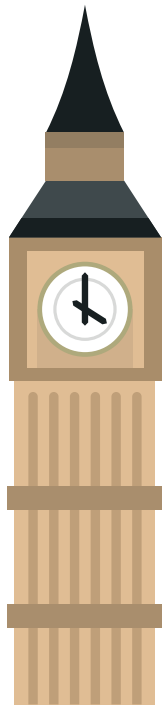

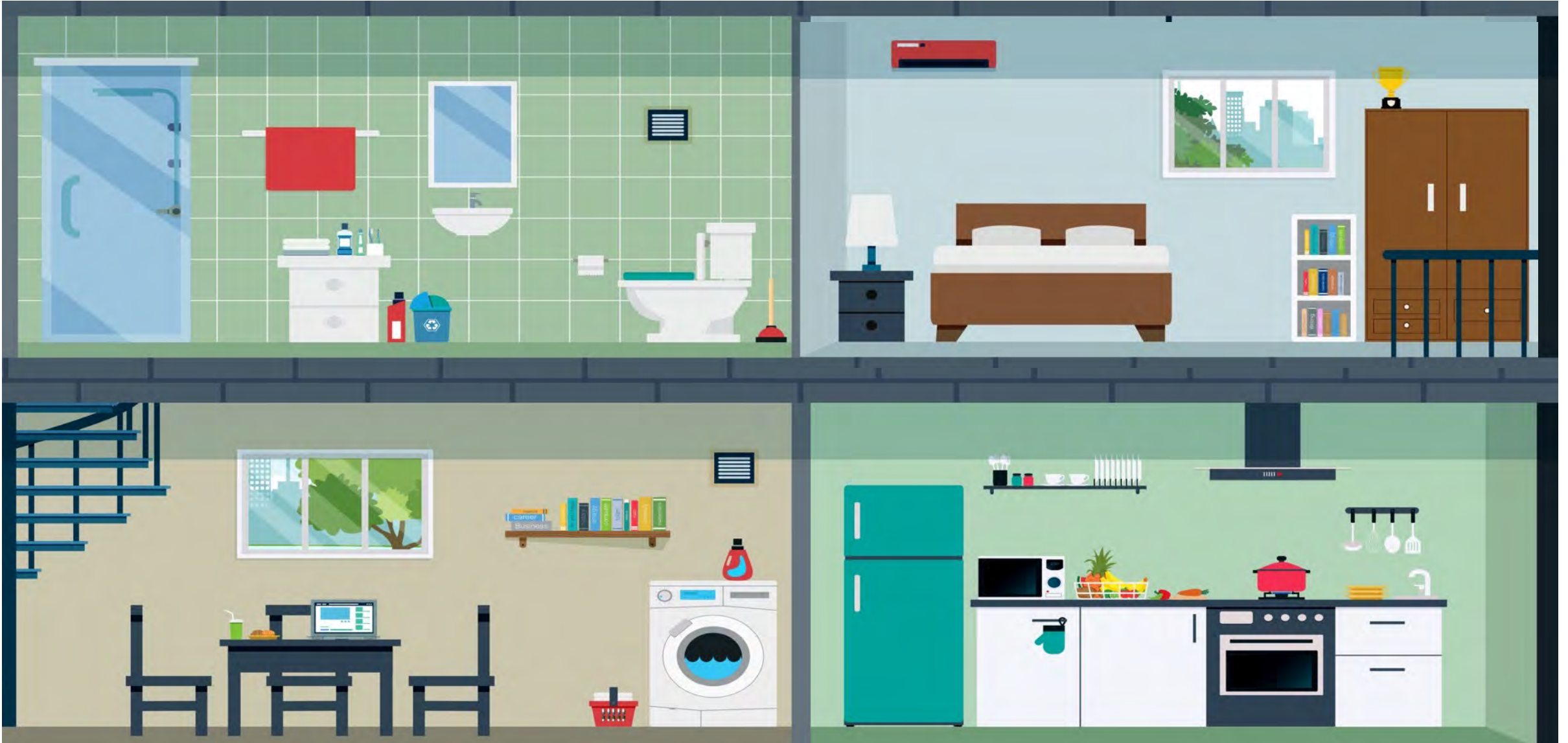

**A**braham

**G**reen **S**treet

**N**ew **Y**ork

**M**exico

**T**ower of **B**abel

**B**lack **S**ea

**C**ity **H**ospital

**M**r., **M**rs., **M**iss and **M**s.

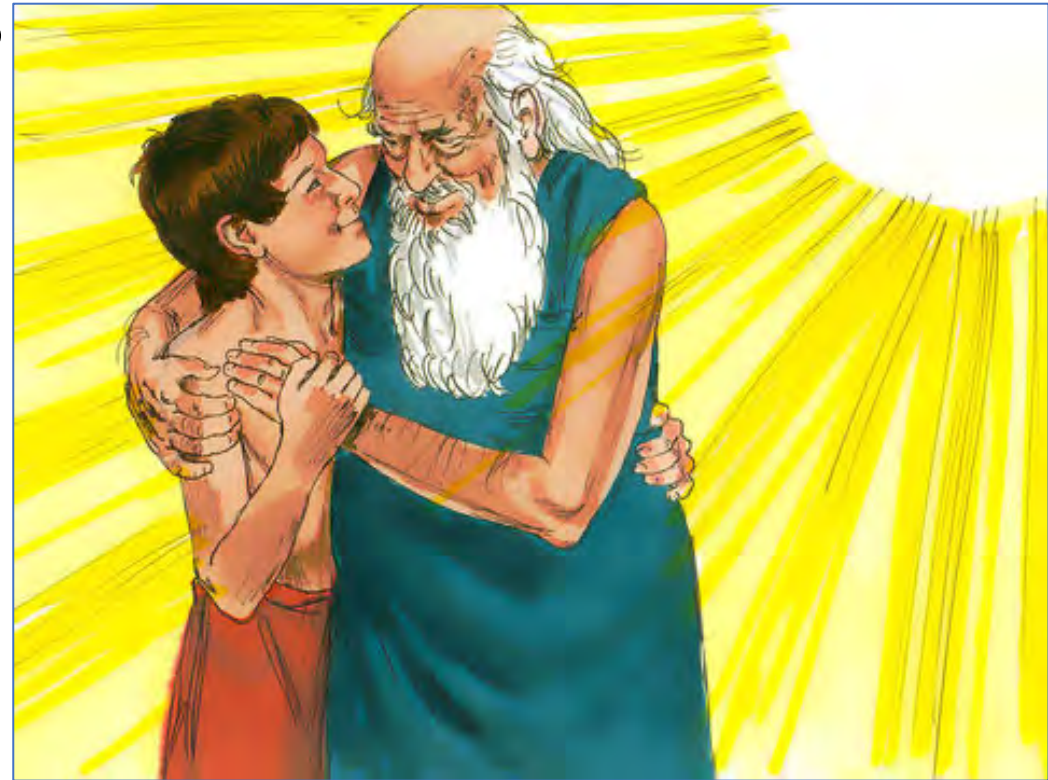
