People Need a Better Sacrifice

[Ezekiel 36:22–27;](#)

[1 Samuel 15:22–23;](#) [Hebrews 10:1–10](#)



Hundreds of years passed. The people of God did not obey the laws that Moses gave. God sent many teachers to preach his word. But the people still did not obey. So God let other nations defeat them.



But God did not forget his promise to Abraham. He told Abraham that his children would be a blessing to all the people on earth.



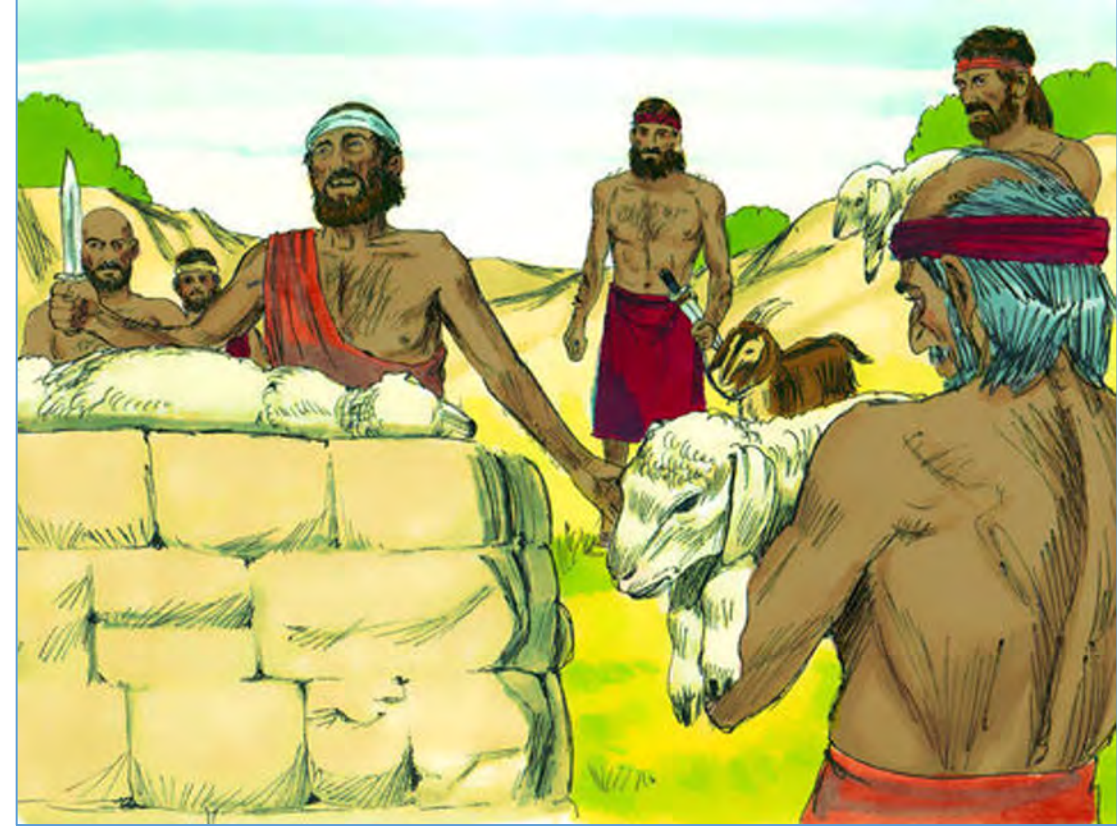


So God said, “I will gather people for Me from every nation. I will clean them from their sin. I will give them a new heart. I will put My Spirit in them so they will obey.”





Under Moses' law, people had to sacrifice animals for their sins. They had to make these sacrifices every year. The people made their sacrifices but they did not change their hearts.





God said, "I do not need the blood of animals, but I need an obedient heart." So He said, "I will prepare a better sacrifice. It will only need to be made once, for all people."

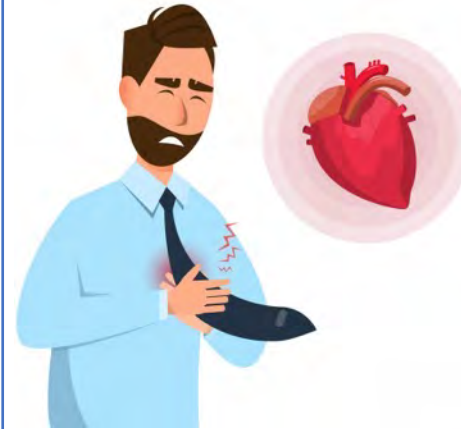
