and Other Prophesies from the Old Testament - <u>Isaiah 53</u>




God planned a better sacrifice for people's sins.

He sent his prophets (messengers) to tell them about it.



God told the prophets that this new, perfect sacrifice will not be made with animals, but with a Special Person, the "Messiah."

God's prophets wrote about this Special Person:





He will be a relative of King David.

(<u>Isaiah 11:1, 2, 10</u>)

He will be called the Messiah, meaning the chosen King.

(<u>Daniel 9:25a</u>)





He will be born to a virgin.

(Isaiah 7:14)

He will be filled with God's Holy Spirit.



He will be a Servant and a Light to the people of every nation.



He will be called Immanuel – "God with us" and Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Prince of Peace.






