Jesus taught his disciples what would happen. He said, "I will be given to my enemies. They will kill me. But I will rise to life three days later."



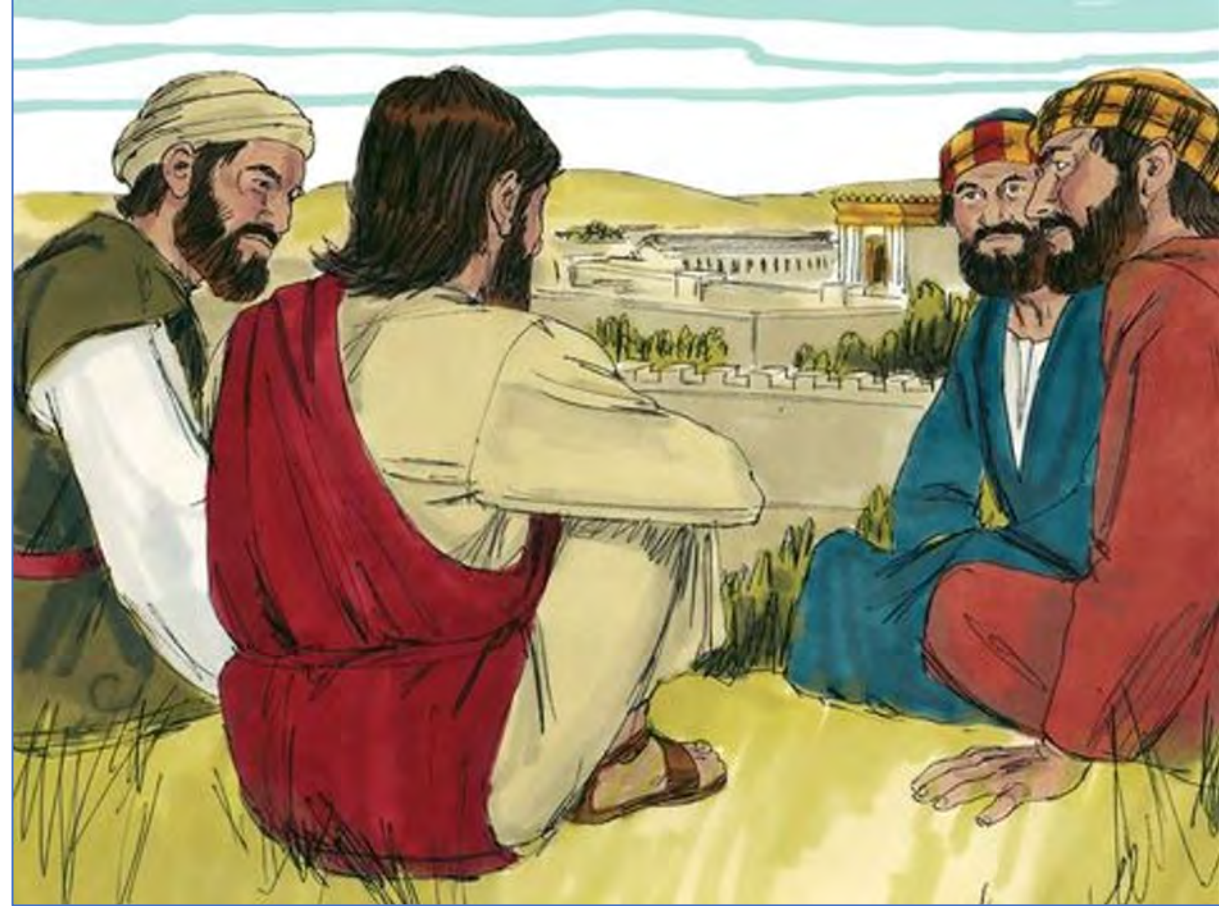


Peter said, "No, you must never be killed!" Jesus said to Peter, "Go away from me. You are thinking like a man. You are not thinking what God wants. You are thinking what Satan wants."





Then Jesus talked to his disciples and to the people. He said: “A person must forget about himself if he wants to be my follower.”





A person who loves his life will lose it one day. But any person will save his life if he gives it away for me and the gospel. Any person who wants to serve me must follow me. Then my Father will help him to be a good disciple.”

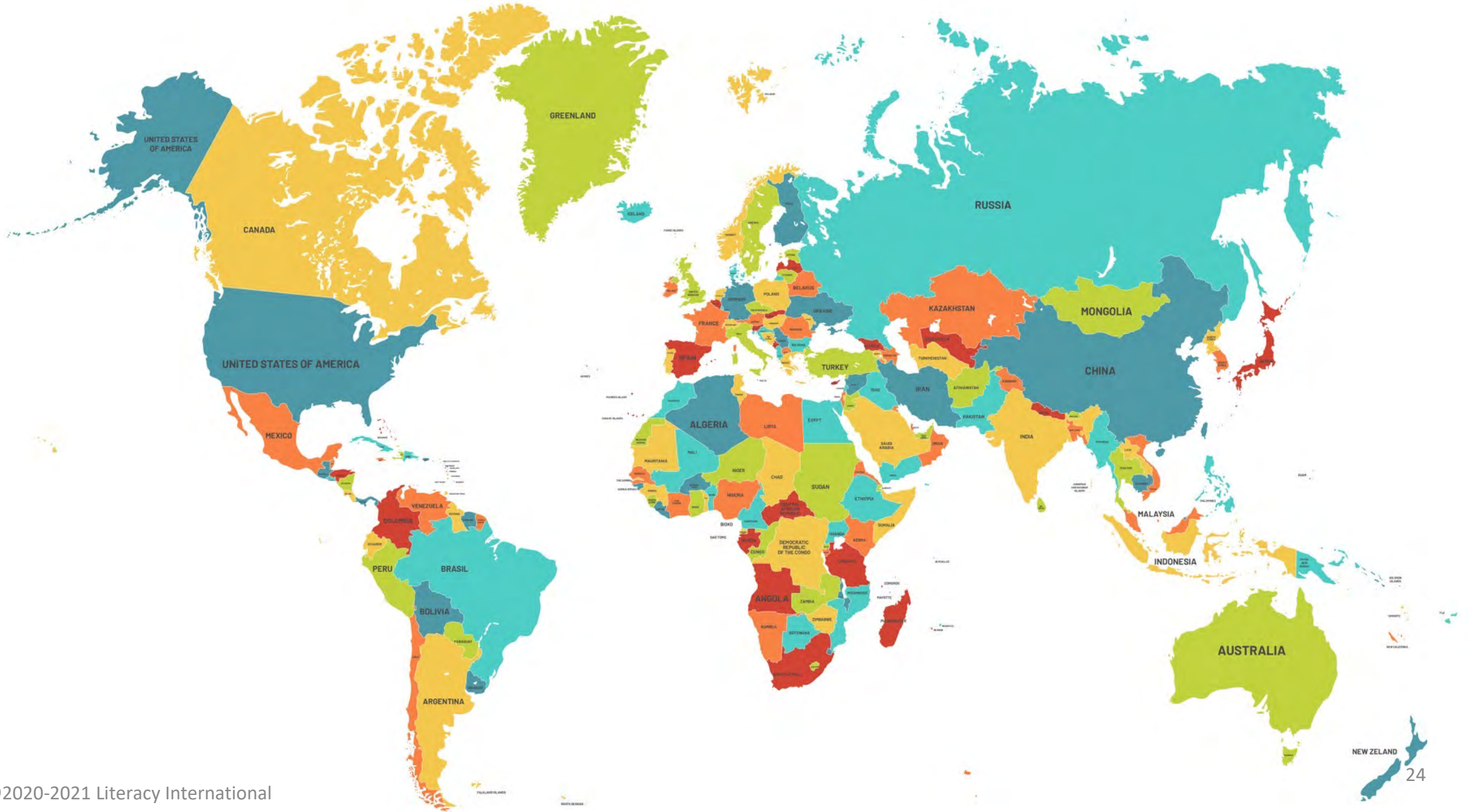
