


Mary Magdalene went to the grave where Jesus was buried. Another woman named Mary went with her.

The angel said to the women, "Do not be afraid. You are looking for Jesus. He is not here! He has risen from the dead." The angel told the women to go and tell the disciples.






Later, Peter and John went to the grave. Jesus was not there. This was just as the women had told them. Jesus had risen from the dead.


That evening, the disciples were meeting together.
Jesus came into the locked room. He said, "Peace be with you." He showed them his hands and his side.






