












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
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Irregular Verbs - Listen and repeat.

do	did	We did a big job.
go	went	They went to the small house.
have	had	I had a big breakfast.
say	said	He said the cup was empty.
see	saw	We saw the soft sofa.



Question ?	Negative -	Affirmative +
Did you have a hot drink yesterday?	No, I didn't have a hot drink.	I had a cold drink.
Did he buy a big meal?	No, he didn't buy a big meal.	He bought a small meal.
Did they see an old man at the door?	No, they didn't see an old man.	They saw a young man.



Stephen was dead. The religious leaders of the Jews killed him. Now, they tried to hurt the church people in the city. They did not want more people to believe in Jesus.






A man named Philip was another believer. He preached about Jesus. Many people listened to him. He did great things for God.







The man said, "Look! Here is some water. Will you baptize me?" So both men went into the water. There Philip baptized the man.




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The important leader returned to his own country. He was happy and full of faith. This was because now he knew about Jesus.


