





# Like and Would Like: Listen and repeat.

<b>Do</b> you <b>like</b> to play soccer?	Yes, I always <b>like</b> to play soccer.	No, I <b>don't like</b> to play soccer.
<b>Does</b> he <b>like</b> to exercise?	Yes, he <b>likes</b> to exercise every day.	No, he <b>doesn't like</b> to exercise.
Would you like to practice now?	Yes, I'd like to practice.	No, I <b>wouldn't like</b> to practice.
Would she like to walk tomorrow?	Yes, she'd like to walk.	No, she <b>wouldn't like</b> to walk.



#### Quotation marks "" and commas,

Quotation marks show the words someone said. Commas go between the words **said** or **asked** and the quotation marks.

Jesus said, "Every person who believes in me will be saved."

God said, "I have heard your prayers."

Jesus asked, "Who do you say I am?"

Peter said, "You are the Christ, the son of the living God."

There was a man named Cornelius.


He was not a Jew. He was a good man and worshiped the true God. He prayed to God and did good things for other people.

But Peter said, "No. I do not eat things which are unclean."


The voice said, "It is all right. God has made all these things clean." This happened three times. Then Peter could not see the sheet any more.

The next day, Peter went with the men to Cornelius' house. Peter said, "I had a strange vision. Now I know what the vision means.


All people are the same in God's eyes. It is not important what


This is an important story. God wants us to know that Jesus did not die just for the Jews. Jesus died for every person. This is good news for all people in the whole world.




