



Jesus is going to return.


John 14:3; Acts 1:9-11; I Thessalonians 4:13-18, 5:1-4; Matthew 24:35-44

Jesus is going to return. He said, "I myself will come back. I will take you home with me." This promise gives us hope in this life.





Jesus lived here on earth. Then he left to go back to his Father in heaven. His disciples watched him go. Two angels dressed in white clothes came to the disciples.



They said, "Jesus has gone to heaven, but he will come back. He will come back in the same way that you saw him go."

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Then the people who are alive are going to go to meet the Lord. We are going to meet him in the sky. Then we are going to live with him forever.






