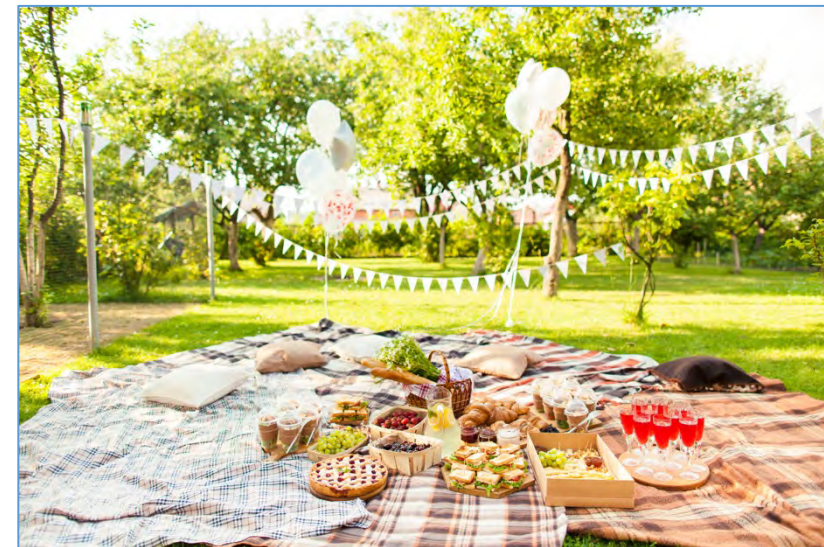
A: What is your favorite season?

They said, "Jesus has gone to heaven, but he will come back. He will come back in the same way that you saw him go."



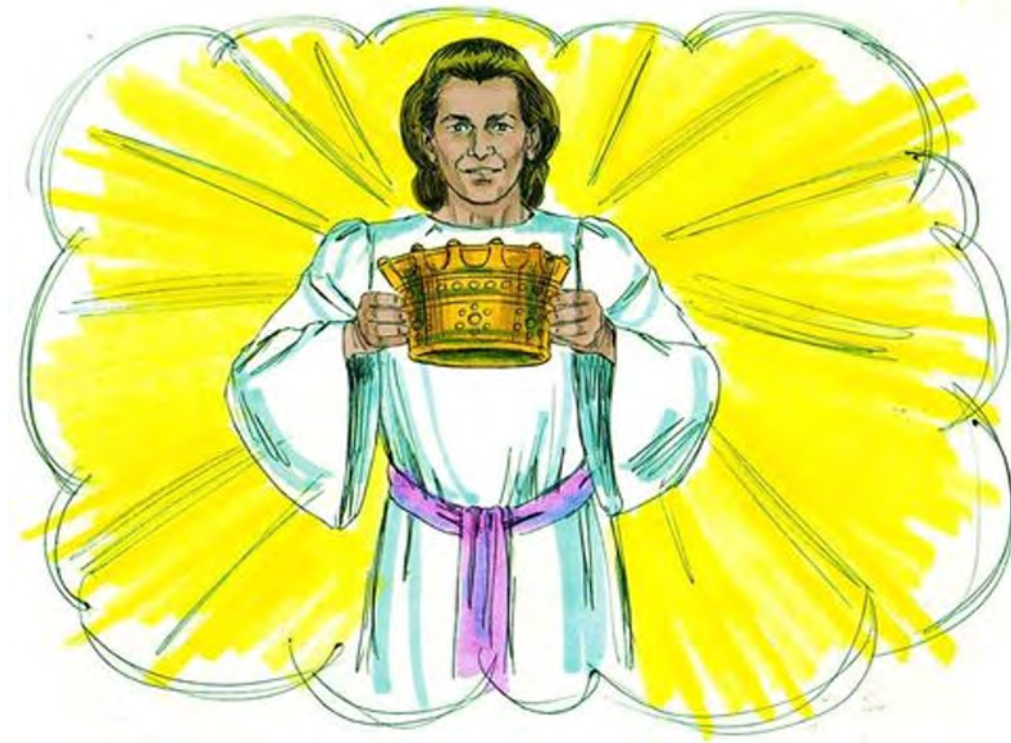

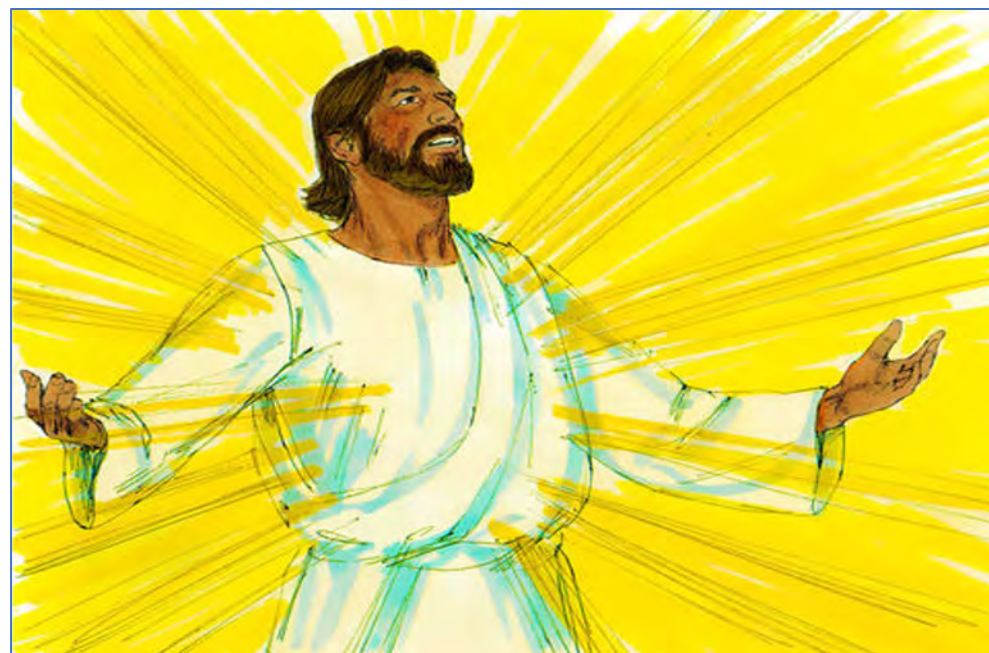
He said: "No one knows the day or hour. The angels do not know. I do not know. Only God the Father knows. You must always be ready. I am coming again when you do not think I will come."

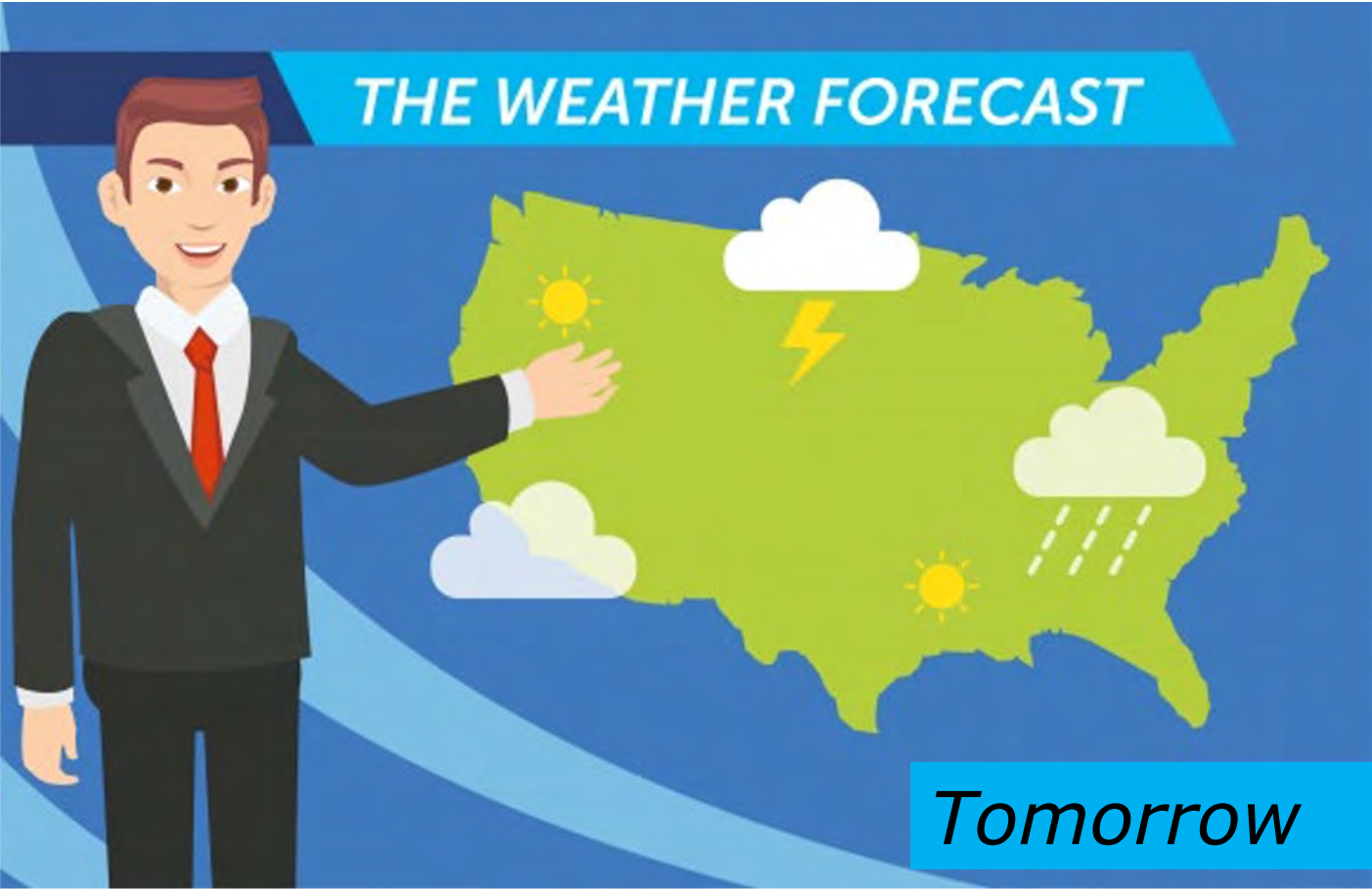

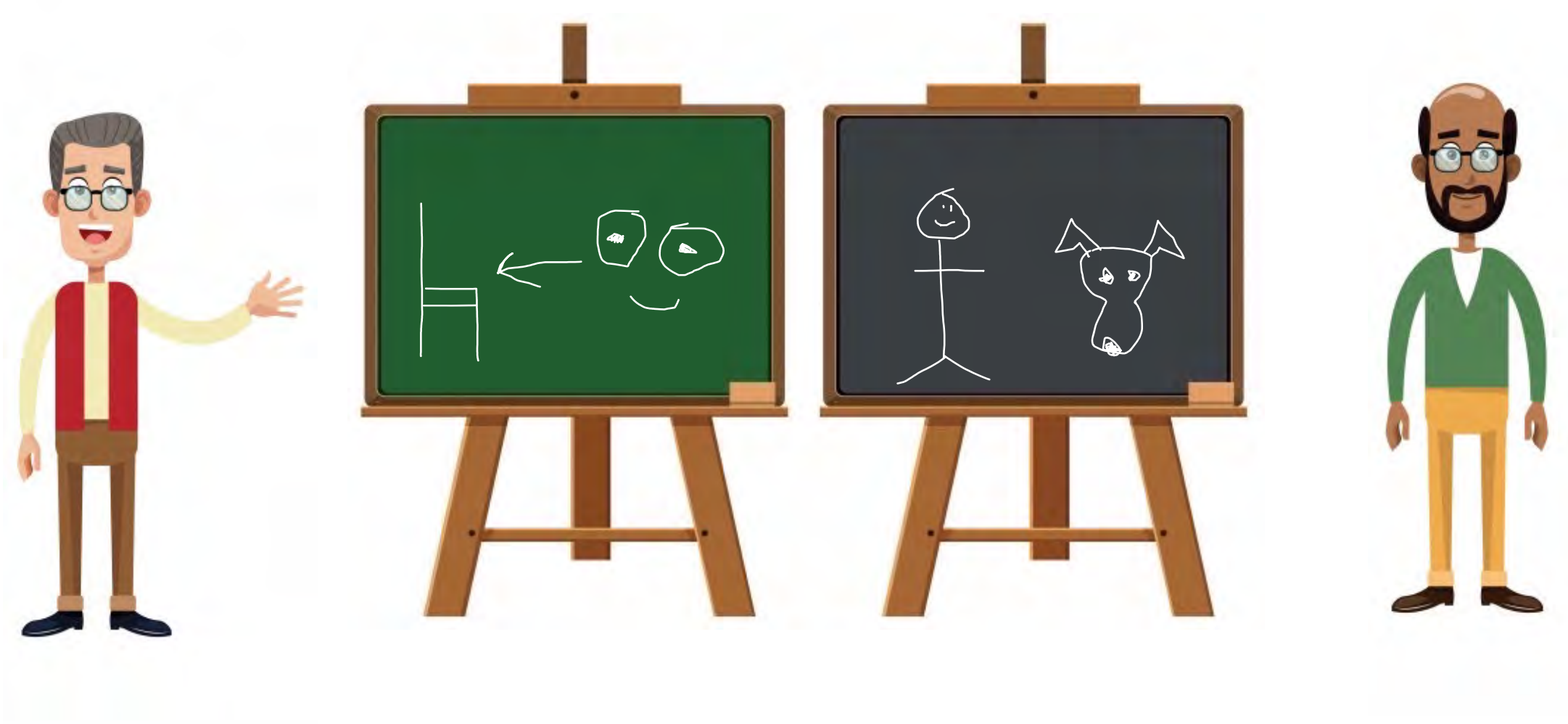
