So Eve ate the fruit. Then she gave the fruit to Adam. He ate it, too. They did not obey God. They sinned.

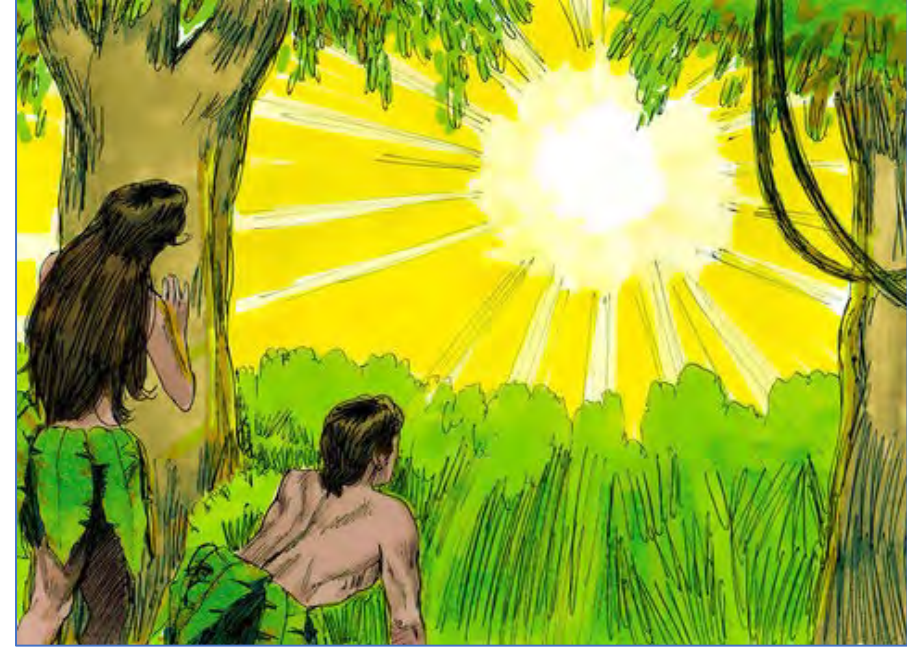


 Adam and Eve knew they were wrong. So they hid from God.

not to eat?"

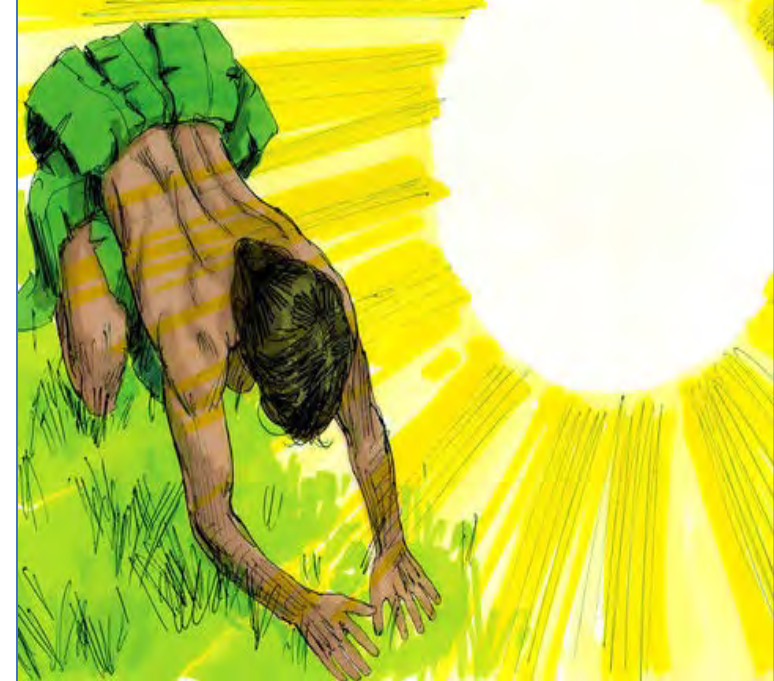
Adam said, "Eve gave me the

eat it. And I ate it."



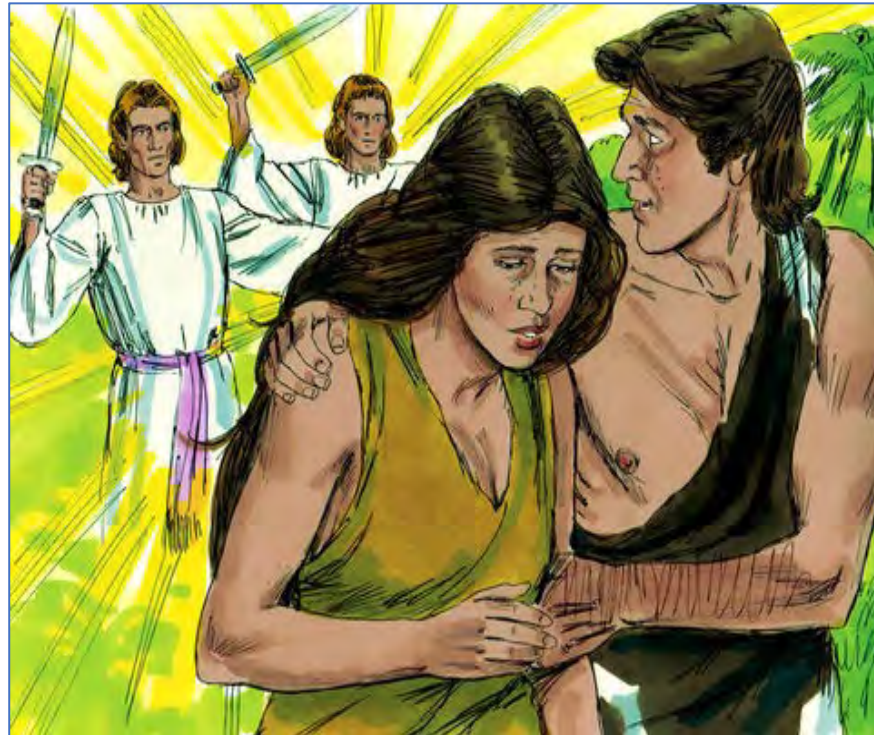


God punished the snake and Adam and Eve, because they did not obey Him.

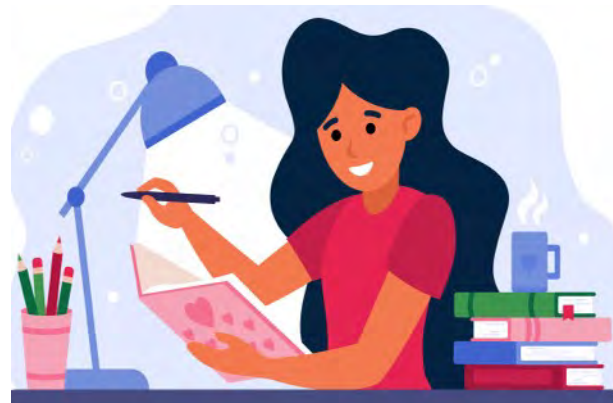

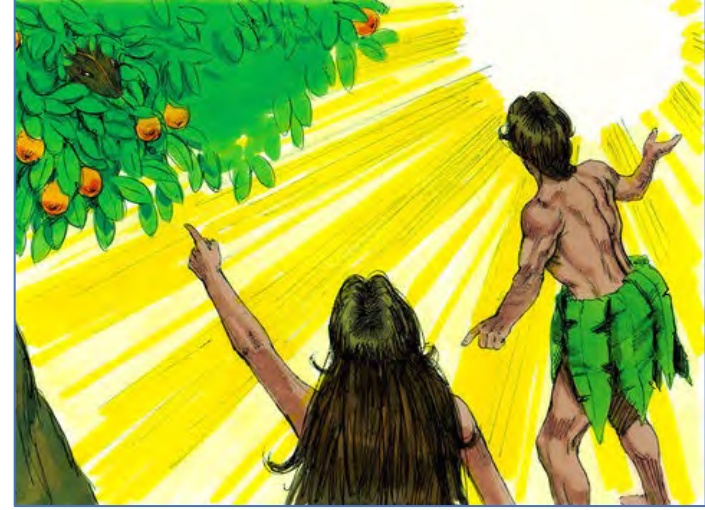
