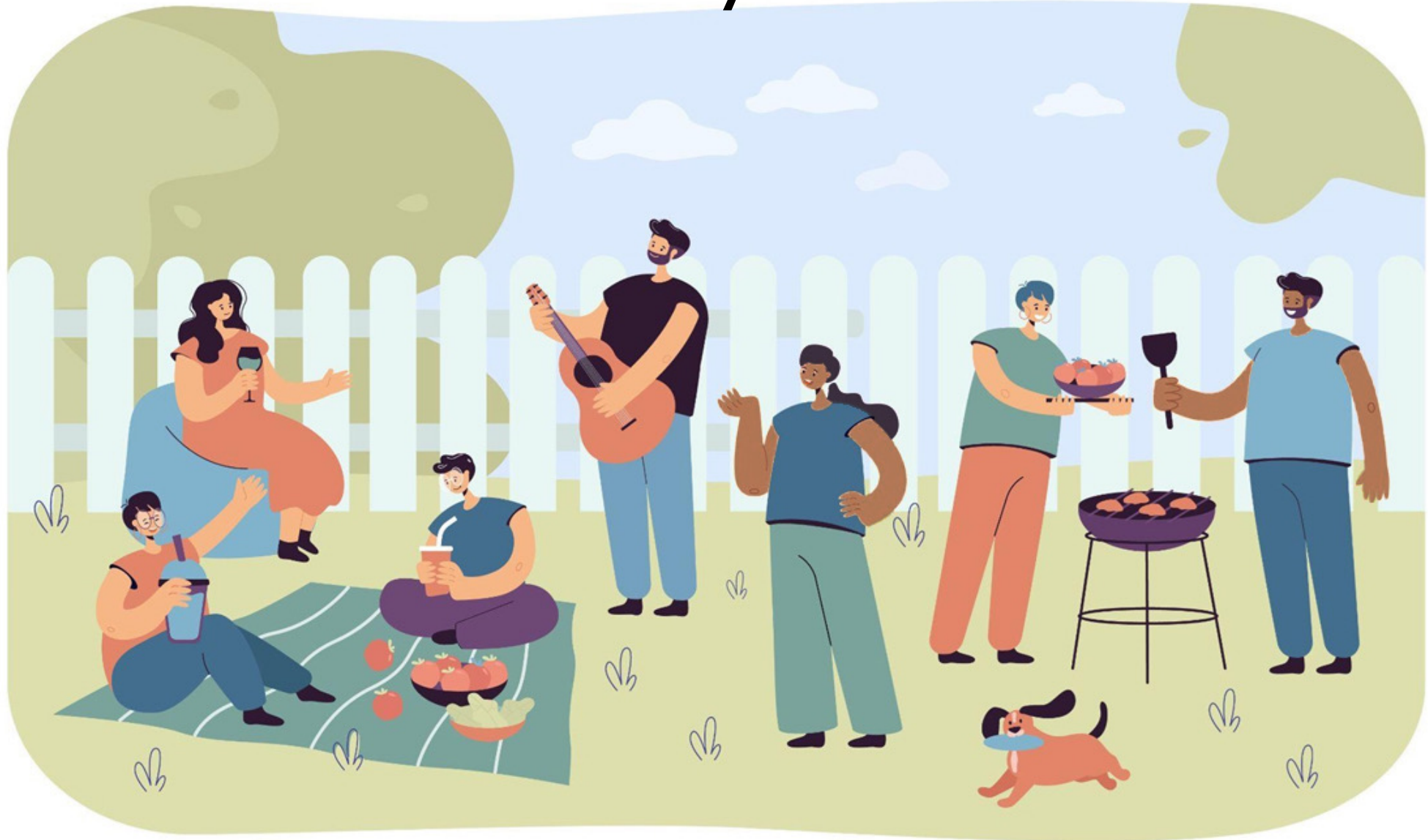

but	To give an objection or another opinion	I like most vegetables, but I don't like mushrooms.
so	To give a conclusion	There's ice on the road, so I don't want to drive.

Conjunction and Use		Examples
then	To tell what happened after something else or because of something else	We went to the park, then we ate cheese pizza. If she sleeps well, then she will feel better.
because	To give reasons	The boy is sad because his ice cream melted. I can't go to the barbeque because it's too late.
