The Birth of John.

[Luke 1:5-80](#)

In the past, God spoke to his prophets so they could speak to his people. Then came 400 years of silence in which he did not speak to men. Then God sent an angel to a priest named Zechariah. Zechariah and his wife, Elizabeth, honored God. They were very old, and she had never had a child. The angel said to Zechariah, "Your wife will have a son. You will name him John. God will fill him with the Holy Spirit, and John will prepare the people for the Messiah!"






Zechariah replied, "My wife and I are too old to have children! How can I know you are telling me the truth?"

The angel said, "I am Gabriel. God sent me to bring you this good news. Because you did not believe me, you will not be able to speak."

Immediately, Zechariah was unable to speak. The angel left Zechariah. After this Zechariah returned home and his wife became pregnant. She did not go out of her house for five months. She said, "Look what the Lord has done for me! He decided to help me. Now people will stop thinking there is something wrong with me"

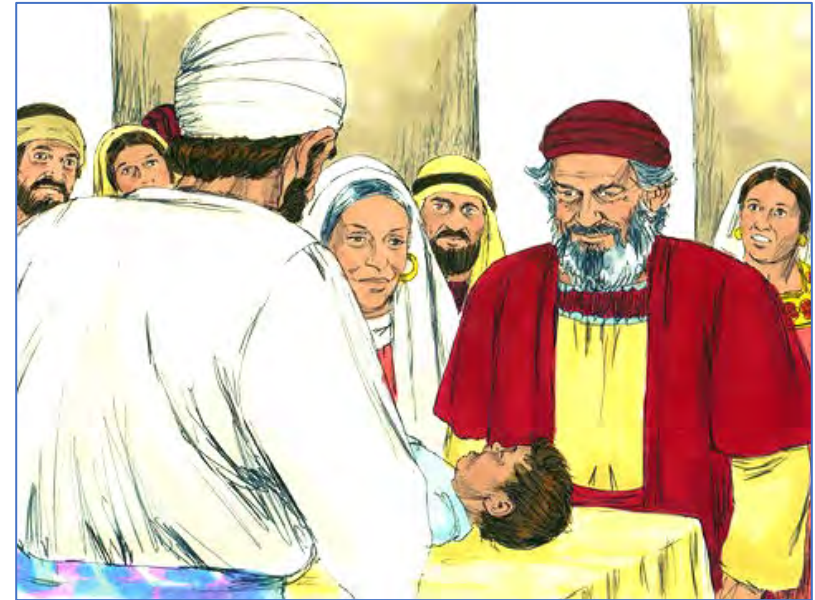
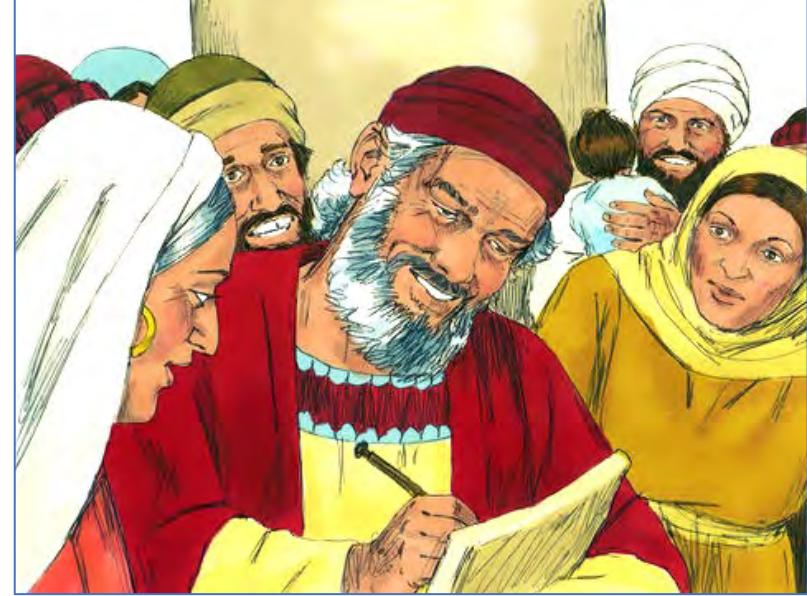


The people said to Elizabeth, "But no one in your family has that name."

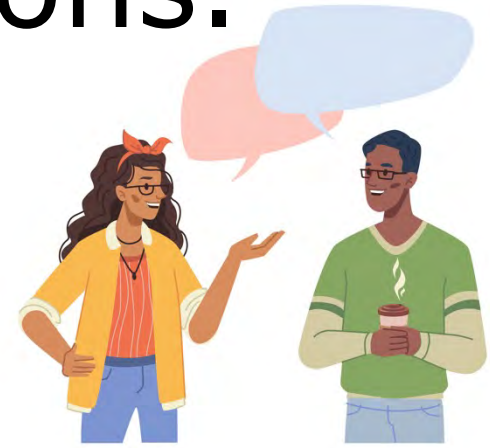

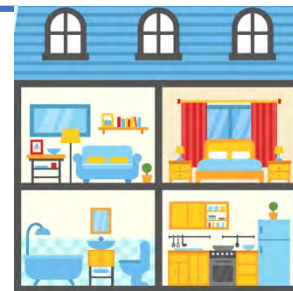

Home Safety

Did you know that most accidents happen at home? It might seem strange, but your home can be a dangerous place. Learning how to avoid fires, how to prevent falls, and how to keep children safe from sharp tools and dangerous products is important.

It's easy to make some small changes in your house or apartment to make it safer for you and your loved ones.

Here are some home safety tips:

Do not let lamps touch curtains because they can catch on fire. Do not run lamp wires under the carpet or rugs. That might start a fire. Do not leave lamp cords on the carpet, where you walk, or you might trip and fall. Do not climb alone onto the roof to make repairs. You can fall. Always ask someone to help you. Keep stairs well-lit and free from clutter. If you live in an apartment, do not use the elevator during a fire or during a bad storm. The electric power can stop and you can get stuck in the elevator. Keep chemicals, garden tools, and knives away from children. In other words, always choose safety first!

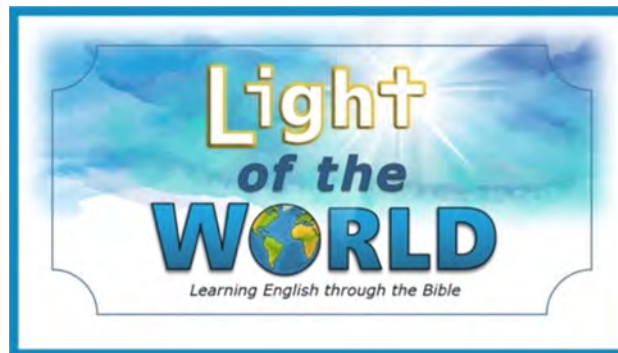
