# An Eye Exam

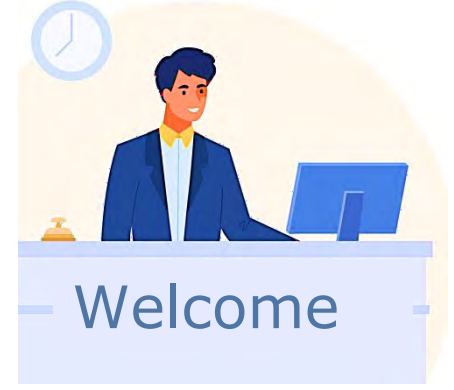
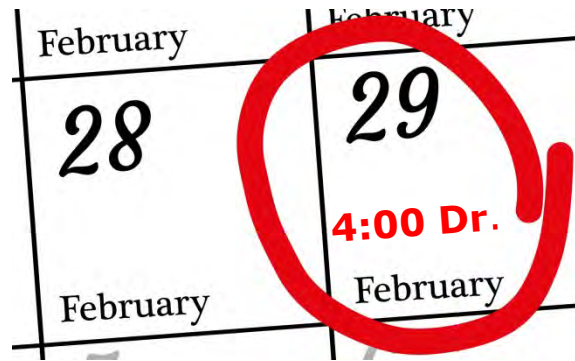

# The Good Samaritan

Luke 10:25-37

One day, an expert in the Jewish law stood up to test Jesus. He said to

Jesus, "Teacher, what must I do to get eternal life?"

Jesus said to him, "What is written in God's law? What do you understand from it?"

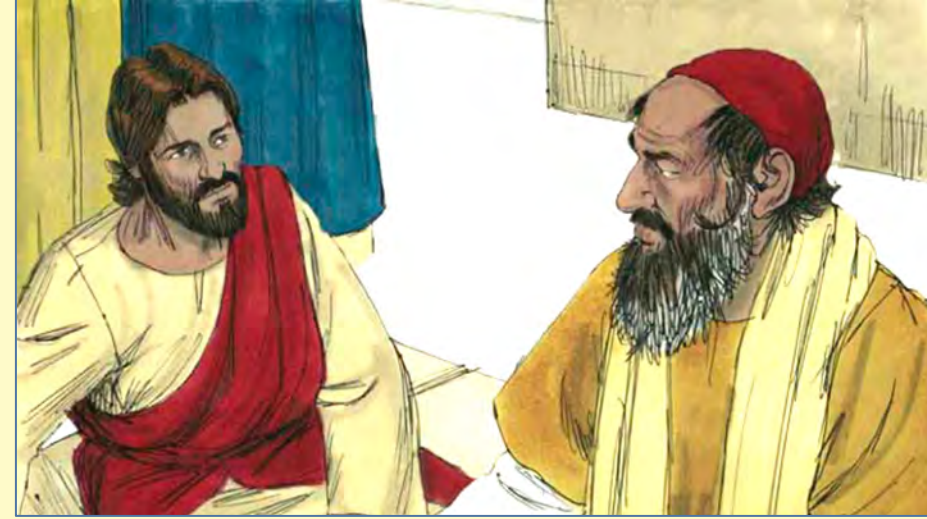
The man answered, "It says, 'Love the Lord your God with all your heart, all your soul, all your strength, and all your mind. Also, 'Love your neighbor the same as you love yourself.'"

Jesus answered, "You are correct! Do this and you will have eternal life."





But the law expert wanted to show that his way of living was correct. So he asked Jesus, "But, who is my neighbor?"

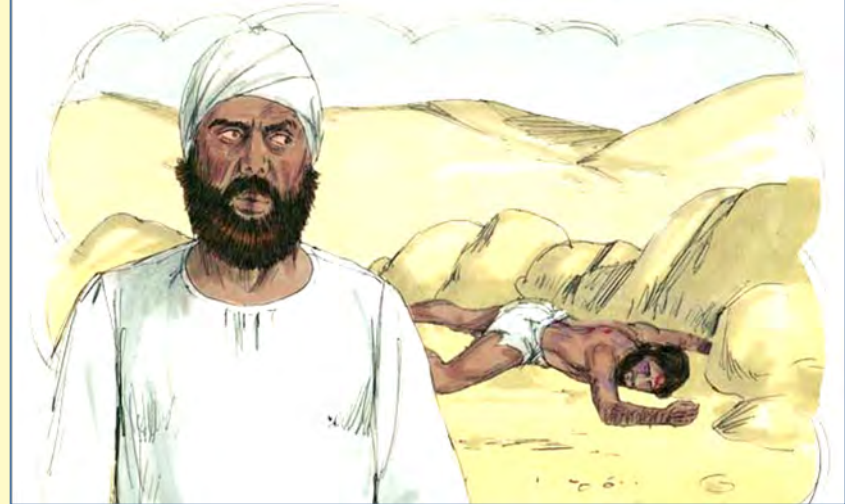


Jesus answered the law expert by telling a story. He said, "A man was going down the road from Jerusalem to Jericho. But some robbers saw him and attacked him. They tore off his clothes, took everything he had, and beat him until he was almost dead. Then they left him lying there on the ground and went away."





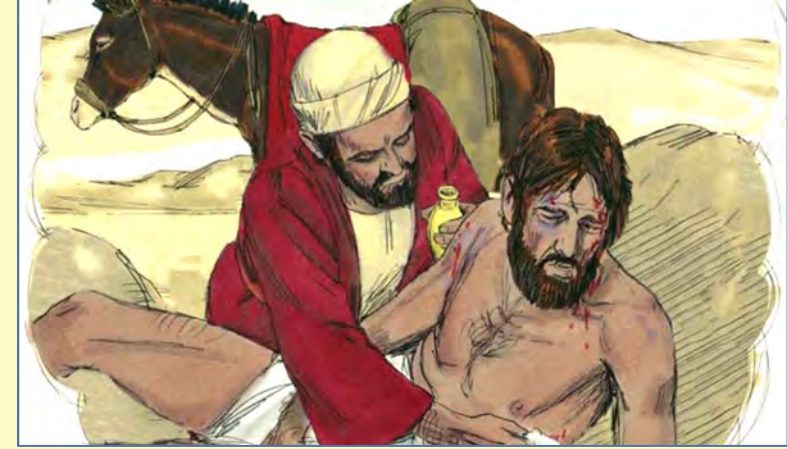
“Soon after that, a Jewish priest happened to walk down that same road. This priest saw that man lying in the road. When he saw him, he did not stop to help him. He moved to the other side of the road and kept on going. He completely ignored that man.”



“Not long after that, a Levite came down the road. (Levites were a tribe of Jews who helped the priests at the Temple.) The Levite also crossed over to the other side of the road. He also ignored that man and walked away.”



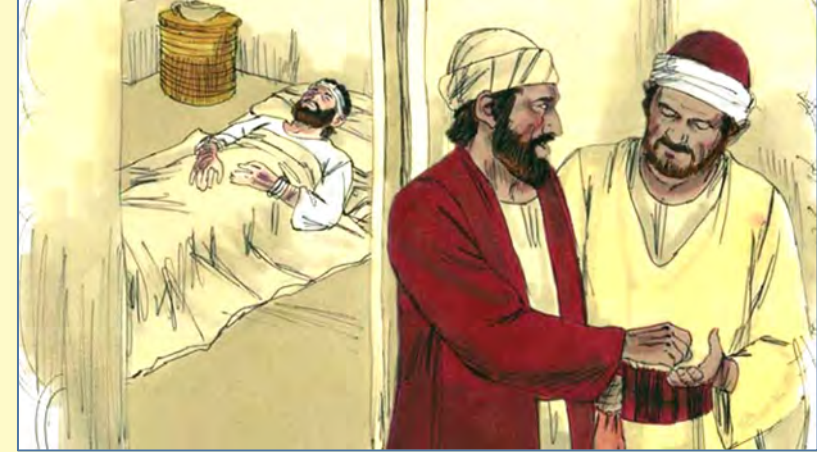
“The next person to walk down that road was a Samaritan, a man from Samaria. (Samaritans and Jews hated each other.) The Samaritan saw the man in the road. He saw he was Jewish, but he still felt sorry for him and had strong compassion for him. So he went over to help him. He poured olive oil and wine on his wounds and bandaged them.



Then the Samaritan lifted the man onto his own donkey. He took him to an inn by the road. There he continued to take care of him.”



"The next day, the Samaritan needed to continue his journey. He took out some money, two silver coins, and gave them to the person in charge of the inn. He said to him, 'Take care of this hurt man. If you spend any more money on him, I will pay it back to you when I return.'"

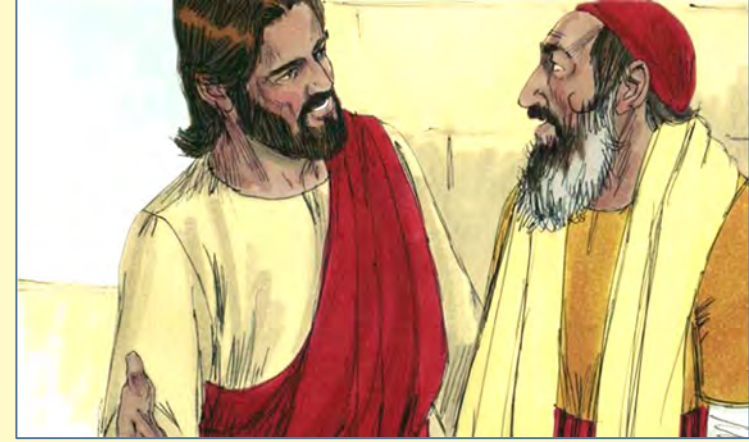


Then Jesus asked the law expert, "What do you think? Which one of the three men was a neighbor to the man who was robbed and beaten?"
